Denali National Park, Alaska

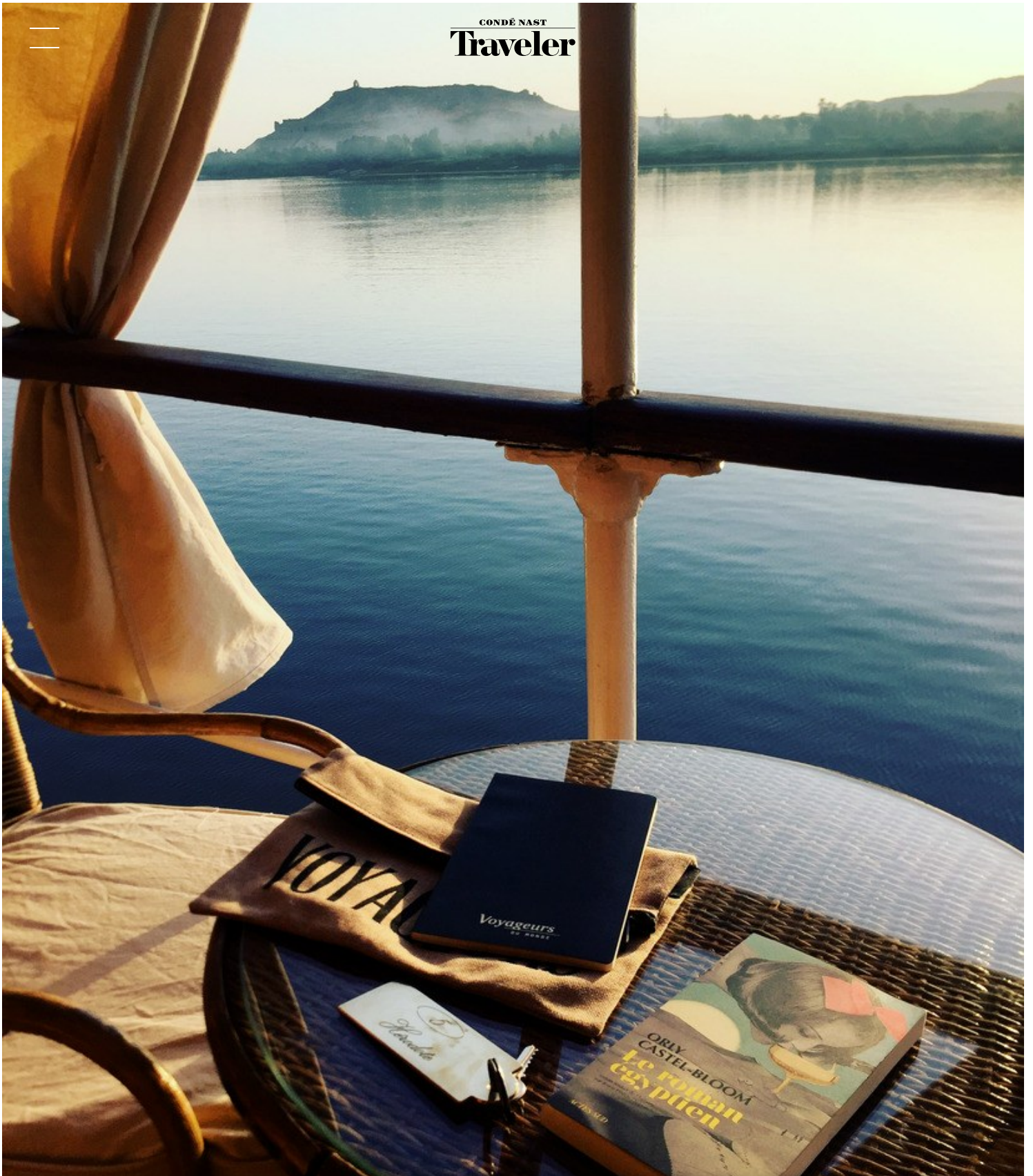
"We took a 45-minute helicopter ride from Talkeetna through the Alaska Range before setting down by a tiny hexagonal chalet on a *nunatak*, or glacial outcropping. This new property is so remote, the owners say only 60 people have been so far. Its five rooms are intentionally simple to emphasize what's outside: Denali, the highest peak in North America, which I would watch from my window. In summer, the sky doesn't really get dark; the pinks intensify, and then, as it approaches midnight, it just shifts into beautiful magentas and purples." *—Kate Cunningham*

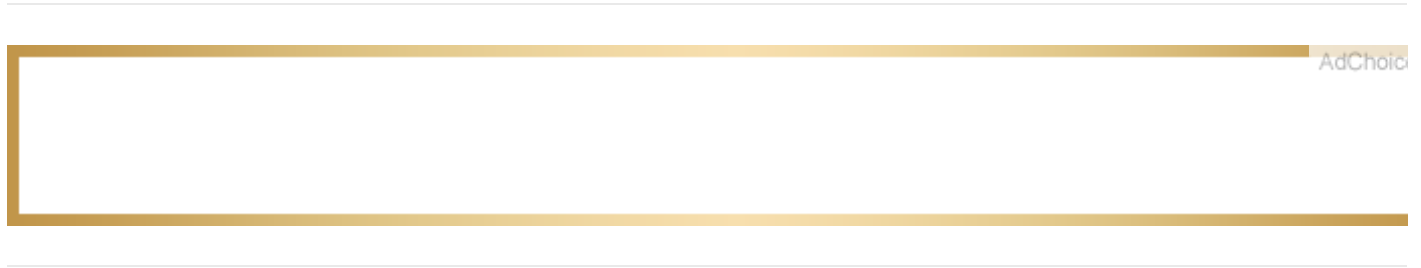
