## 18 José Ignacio, Uruguay

The boho-luxe coastal village of José Ignacio is stealing a march on its glamorous neighbour, Punta del Este, thanks in part to the three "art hotels" developed by billionaire investor Alexander Vik. Bahia Vik (bahiavik.com; doubles from £340) is the most recent addition with bungalows clad in timber, copper and zinc just steps from the surf. Estancia Vik José Ignacio (estanciavik.com, doubles from £310) appeals too, with its stable of ponies, colourful artwork and black granite swimming pool.
